**INFORMATION REGARDING YOUR LEVEL 1 LEARNER'S LICENSE**  
 You may operate a motor vehicle only when accompanied by a licensed parent or legal guardian or, with permission of the parent or legal guardian, any licensed driver 21 years of age or older.

To be eligible for a level 2 license you must:

1. Be at least 16 years old.
2. Possess a graduated level 1 learner's license for at least 6 months.
3. Successfully complete a segment 2 driver education course approved by the Department of Education.
4. Have no convictions or civil infractions, license suspensions, or at-fault crashes for the 90-day period immediately preceding your application.
5. Certify that you have accumulated at least 50 hours of behind-the-wheel experience, of which not less than 10 hours was at night, while accompanied by your parent or legal guardian or, with permission of parent or legal guardian, by an licensed driver 21 years of age or older.
6. Have you parent or legal guardian certify the 50 hours of behind-the-wheel experience.
7. Meet physical and mental standards set by the Department of State
8. Pass a road skills test administered an approved examiner. A list of approved examiners is available at your local branch office.

Segment 2 Driver Education Certificate of Completion – Back (White)

**To apply for a level 2 driver license from the Secretary of State, you must:**

1. Be at least 16 years of age.
2. Have possessed a Level 1 driver license for at least six months.
3. Have successfully completed a Segment 2 driver education course.
4. Have not incurred a moving violation conviction or been involved in an accident during the 90-day period immediately prior to applying for a Level 2 driver license.
5. Have a parent or legal guardian certify that son/daughter has been provided at least 50 hours of driving experience (10 hours must have occurred at night) after receipt of the Level 1 driver license.
